

Why does our staff stay in host homes?

We believe that, by God's design, growth and transformation happen best within relationships. Host homes allow our staff a unique discipleship opportunity to grow and be transformed alongside you and your family!

Who would stay in my home?

A minimum of three college students of the same gender would stay in your home. If you have the ability to host more, even better! Let us know how many you are able to accommodate.

How long will I host them?

Our staff will arrive at your home Saturday evening prior to your week of camp and will leave your home the following Saturday morning. This is a total of seven nights in your home.

Where will they sleep?

Every Discover Camp staff member will need their own designated bed space. Air mattresses are a great option, and we're happy to bring some along if needed—just let us know in advance!

Where will they bathe?

We ask that our staff have access to a full bathroom that will not be shared with the rest of the family.

Will I need to provide transportation?

T Bar M will handle all transportation for our staff throughout the week. To help minimize travel time, we kindly ask that host homes be located within 20 minutes of the partner church site, if possible.

Will I need to provide meals?

Yes, providing meals is a big part of what we ask of you as a host home. We ask that you provide breakfast for our staff each morning. Since we leave early, a grab-and-go breakfast works perfectly. We also ask that you provide dinner and share a meal with our staff on three scheduled evenings during the week.

Will they need to do laundry?

Our staff typically do their laundry during their off time on weekends. However, if your washer and dryer are available to them during the week, they would greatly appreciate it!
