

CAMP TRAVIS

2025 PACKING LIST



- Sheets (twin sized) and 1 light sleeping bag or blanket
- 1 pillow and 1 pillow case
- Laundry bag with Camper's name in BIG letters
- 1 bath towel, 1 pool towel, 2 washcloths
- 4-5 pairs of shorts (minimum of fingertip length)
- 7-8 t-shirts (tank tops must appropriately cover undergarments; no "spaghetti" straps)
- Deep in the Heart theme tee or your favorite T Bar M shirt (not required, but we encourage you to wear this on closing day!)
- 8-10 pairs of underwear
- 2 modest swimsuits (gals: one-pieces with shorts)
- 8-10 pairs of socks
- Water footwear (sandals, flip flops, lake shoes)
- Athletic shoes (closed-toe)
- Theme costumes (optional)
- 1 flashlight
- Small personal fan (w/ batteries or bring 6' extension cord if a plug-in)
- Toiletries (girls no makeup)
- Sunscreen (bring a hat to keep your face out of the sun)
- Bible, paper/notebook and pen
- Water Bottle

What to leave at home:

- Food, candy, and gum. These items will be thrown away.
- Expensive items like cameras, phones, smart watches, etc. We will take these items from the Campers to be returned at the end of the week. T Bar M cannot be held responsible should anything happen to them.
- Makeup - please do not bring! Natural beauty is celebrated at Camp!
- Any type of weapons. We take this seriously and will call parents upon finding anything questionable.

WATER BOTTLE NOTE: Please make sure your Camper packs their own water bottle. T Bar M will not be supplying water bottles to Campers.

Trunk, Suitcase or Duffel Bag? All three options are good! Trunks or suitcases, can't be taller than 16" so it can fit under the bunk.

Helpful Hint: Your empty laundry bag makes a great space to pack your bedding and pillow and free up space to pack everything. Camp Travis cabins are not air conditioned, but no worries! Each cabin has two large fans and a cool breeze off the lake.
